- Joint initiative of BOA and BGS
- Managed by RCP since 2012
- Commissioned by HQIP
- Part of the Falls and Fragility Fracture Audit Programme
- 450,000 records, 100% participation

- Improvement focussed

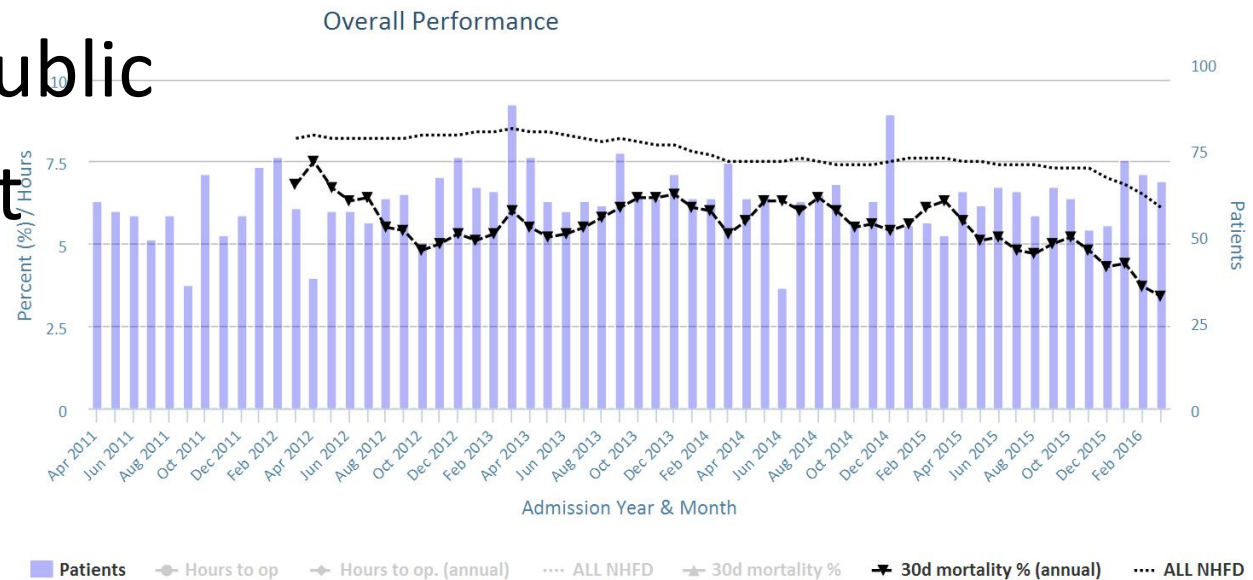
